August Updates

CLINICAL VIEWER PRESENTATIONS

The NWA provided ClinicalViewer Presentations and demos over the summer months to HSPs in the City of Thunder Bay. The Thunder Bay District Health Unit has expressed interest in the Viewer and how it can enhance their delivery of care. We have arranged a subsequent session for their clinicians to access the training environment to provide them with better insight into the available data.

HSPs are excited with recent enhancements to the ClinicalViewer, including a "Medications Portlet" which displays information from the provincial Digital Health Drug Repository (DHDR) for Ontarians with an Ontario Health Number.

Sessions now being coordinated for the fall include a presentation at the Thunder Bay District Mental Health and Addictions Network meeting so that all Network member CEOs in Thunder Bay district are informed of CONER and can initiate a system approach to adoption of the ClinicalViewer.

We continue to reach out to HSPs in clinical sectors including Community Support Services, Mental Health & Addictions, AOHc members and Long-term care. Our focus this fall will be on arranging information sessions and encouraging groups to host a presentation. Please note that we are able to provide an overview of the ClinicalViewer in as little as 40 minutes, and we can tailor a follow-up session with targeted clinicians in your organization!

UPCOMING PRIVACY MEETING

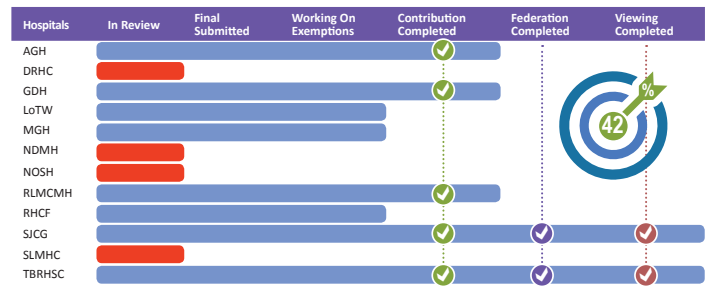

TECHNICAL SERVICE PROVIDER (TSP)

Clinical Validation Testing for contribution continues with 3 of 12 sites. We continue to work through issue identification and resolution with eHealth Ontario. MSO testing and rollout preparation activities continues with all regional sites. Federation testing is scheduled to begin in September 2017.

SECURITY UPDATE

As of August 24 2017, 5 of the 12 hospitals have had their contribution-specific security exemptions/controls approved. **A quick reminder that hospitals must have this work completed before they are able to start Clinical Validation Testing.** At this time, this is the only road block keeping the remaining hospitals from moving into Clinical Validation. If you are one of the 7 hospitals, you can contact Caroline Harding or the resources at eHealth Ontario directly for additional support. Contribution specific security is only one part of the required security work to be completed for the project, as the Viewer and IDP requirements will need to be met prior to end user adoption.



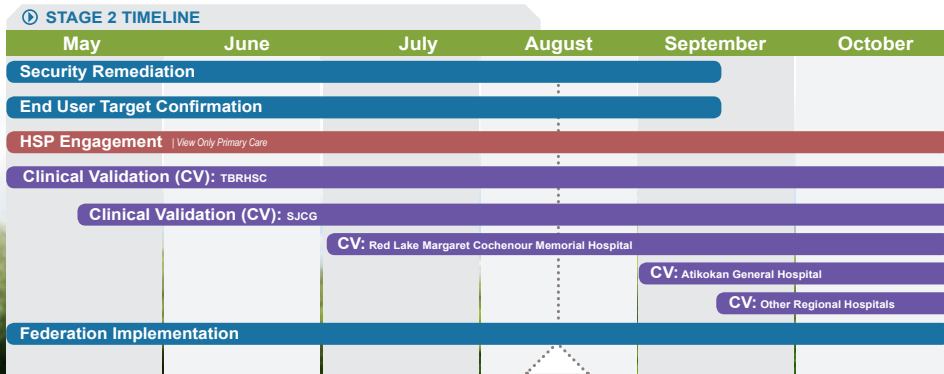
MOUs

Please expect a Stage 3 Memorandum of Understanding coming to the CEOs by the end of August. This will include a schedule extension of Stage 2 activities as well as the addition of Stage 3 activities such as identifying end users, training approach, and registration



Is it possible to access the wrong patient information using the ClinicalViewer?

The system includes safeguards to prevent users from accessing the wrong patient information. Users must enter sufficient patient identity information for a query to return a result, otherwise, a result will not be returned. In the event of multiple patients being returned from a query, users will be prompted to enter additional patient personal information to refine and confirm their search prior to their patient's data being displayed.
