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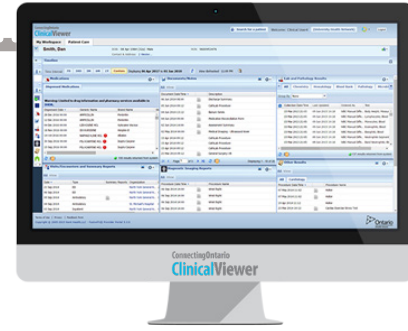
VIEWER ONLY UPDATES

The Northwest Health Alliance (NWhA) will be identifying and communicating with the next group of health service providers (HSPs) who are eligible to receive access to the ConnectingOntario ClinicalViewer. The long-term care sector and health units are next to be assisted with the onboarding process (which includes site engagement, privacy and security readiness, adoption planning, execution of agreements and clinician access) prior to going live.

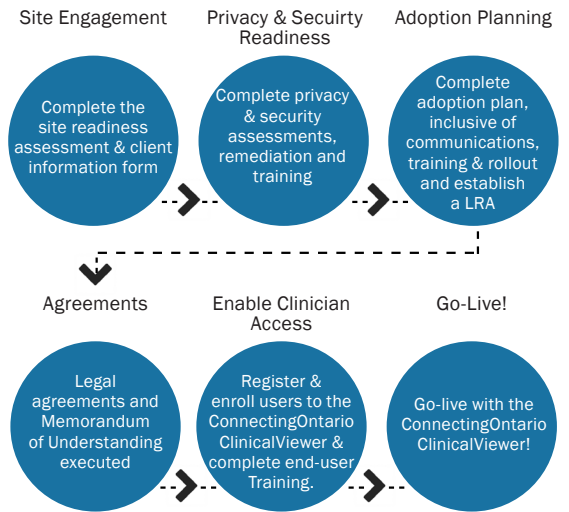
Anishnawbe Mushkiki and the NorWest Community Health Centre are close to completing adoption activities and their clinicians look forward to completing end user training and approaching go-live! The Thunder Bay District Health Unit will be included in the next group of HSPs who are to receive access to the ConnectingOntario ClinicalViewer.

The NWhA will be announcing an additional resource soon, as a physician will be assisting us in working with HSPs, particularly clinics for upcoming program activities.

We continue to encourage organizations to reach out to the NWhA to determine how their clinicians can gain secure and timely access to electronic patient information including OLIS, Drug Repository, Hospital Documents and North West LHIN Home and Community Care Reports, and more!

THE NEXT 30 DAYS...

Adoption Plan:

Sites need to confirm

1. if they plan on enrolling all users in one batch, or in waves, and;
2. how they will conduct the training.

End User Engagement:

Site will need to arrange for Heidi to conduct engagement sessions with the identified end users.

Train the Trainer:

Sites will need to identify who their internal trainer will be for new employees once the project is in operations and the NWhA will provide all training materials they will need.

Privacy & Security Training Integrated into Operations:

Sites will identify how they will integrate the cNER privacy and security training into their day to day operations.



Local Registration Authority Set Up

The NWhA will complete registration forms so the site can request to have an Local Registration Authority (LRA). The site will need to submit the forms themselves and eHealth Ontario will reach out to the site to conduct LRA training.
