### Adoption Activities

Fall 2018 continues to be active for health service providers in our region for those who are pursuing adoption of the Connecting Ontario ClinicalViewer. Clinicians recognize the improved patient care as a result of gaining timely and secure access to patient information including OLIS, Drug Repository, Hospital Documents and LHIN-HCC Reports, and more patient data available in each new Release.

The Northwest Health Alliance (NWhA) will be engaging with NorWest CHC clinicians in Longlac the first week in October in anticipation of connection later in the month, and Anishnawbe Mushkiki Aboriginal Health access Centre now have clinicians accessing the Viewer as well. Other sites being engaged include the Northwestern Health Unit, the Gizhewaadiziwin Access Centre, and Mary Berglund Community Health Centre. Mary Berglund Community Health Centre Hub has completed their Client Information Form (CIF). In addition to completing their CIF they have also completed the Readiness Assessment, Organization Set up Form, and Legal agreements now. They are in contact with NWhA Privacy Officer and eHealth Ontario's Security team.

Bethammi and Hogarth Riverview Manor have received Legal Agreements for execution and will be completing Readiness Assessment and Organization Setup Forms in October.

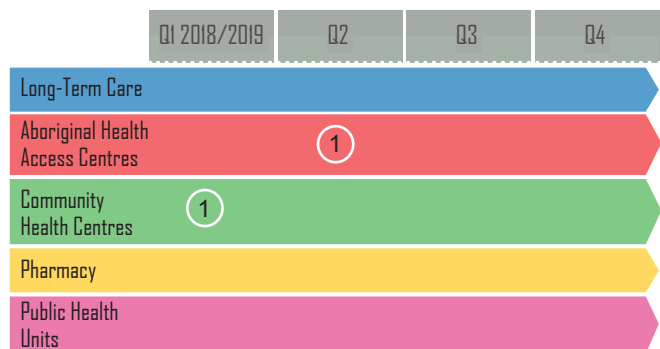
Waasegiizhig Nanaandawe'iyewigamig (Aboriginal Health Access Centre) in Kenora is scheduled to receive their Legal Agreements for execution and is completing Readiness Assessment and Organization Setup Forms in September. In addition, they now have a date set to commence Privacy requirements.

A third long-term care facility in Thunder Bay has been identified as a possible adopter with engagement commencing in October of 2018.

### View-Only Privacy Q&A

**Why do I need to answer contribution related questions on the privacy assessment?**

As part of the onboarding process, health service providers (HSPs) must complete ConnectingOntario privacy training and a privacy assessment for their organization. While some organizations have already expressed that this process would be smoother if the privacy assessment did not include addressing contribution questions for view-only sites. Unfortunately, it is a requirement from the eHealth Ontario Privacy Office that all HSPs complete all questions on the Privacy Assessment, as their sites will need to be aware of the consent directives and access request policies from ConnectingOntario should their site decide to contribute data in the future. If policies change by the time the HSP begins to contribute, eHealth Ontario will remain in contact with the site(s) and inform them of the new policies, but no further requirement would be needed from the site(s) to complete an additional assessment. Completing and addressing the gaps as found during the review of your site's privacy assessment today will save your organization time later on and assist to bring your privacy policies and procedures current with eHealth Ontario and other provincial privacy requirements.
