Adoption Activities

Health service providers (HSPs) in the northwest who have now completed their ConnectingOntario adoption and activity using the ClinicalViewer have already been finding improved patient care as a direct result of having timely and secure access to patient information. This patient information includes OLIS, Drug Repository, Hospital Documents and LHIN-HCC Reports, and more that have assisted in providing improved patient care for these HSPs.

NorWest Community Health Centre clinicians in Longlac have participated in an engagement session this past month and anticipate ClinicalViewer availability by the end of November. They now join NorWest CHC clinicians in Thunder Bay and clinicians at Anishnawbe Mushkiki Aboriginal Health Access Centre in accessing the ClinicalViewer.

Earlier this summer the Thunder Bay District Health Unit were engaged with onboarding activates for the ClinicalViewer. They were in the midst of completing their privacy and security requirements, but due to a strike by the public health nurses at the Thunder Bay District Health Unit, all activities were put on hold by the health care provider.

The two St. Joseph's Care Group (SJCG) long-term care faculties of Bethammi and Hogarth Riverview Manor are reviewing their requirements as they may have additional sites requiring access to the ClinicalViewer in the future.

Waasegiizhig Nanaandawe'yewigamig (Aboriginal Health Access Centre) have executed their legal agreements, completed readiness assessment, organization setup form, and commenced privacy assessment and training. eHealth Ontario is now working with their Local Registration Authority (LRA) to provide the required credentials and security training to complete a draft of their security assessment for November. We would like to thank their leadership and staff who are working diligently to gain ClinicalViewer access for their staff which will improve patient care at their Aboriginal Health Access Centre.

Mary Berglund Community Health Centre Hub in Ignace is completing their security requirements with eHealth Ontario, and has completed their privacy training with Lawrence Badanai, our Privacy Officer. They are now working to complete their privacy assessment on their organization and Lawrence will assist them with addressing any gaps required for privacy compliance.

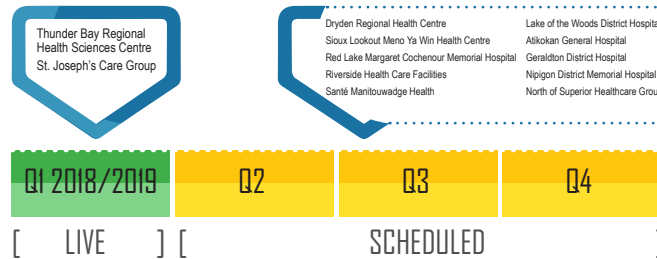

A third long-term care facility in Thunder Bay has now been identified and we are scheduling of adoption engagement session to begin soon with them.

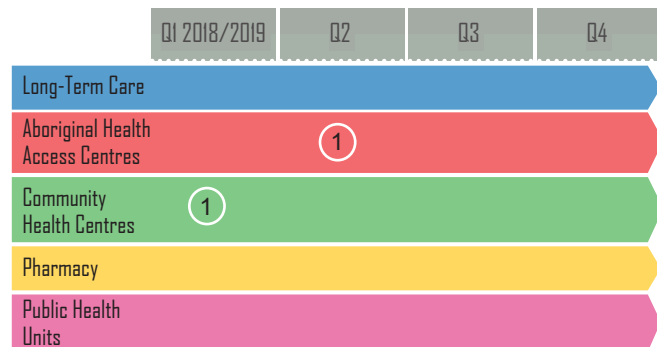
